Semantic Workshop

In this in-depth Semantic Workshop we discuss the semantic foundations with you and consider practical cases together. We target our sessions to your specific requirements and your semantic use-cases, determining all the data required. On top of this we implement your use-case as an illustration.

We use concrete examples to give you an understanding of the concept of Semantic, so that you can use the function in your everyday work on your wiki. You learn how to work properly with Semantic and how to develop a suitable concept. On this basis, you can extend you wiki with Semantic and create professional semantic forms and queries. Get going with Semantic straight away!

Rights Management Workshop

In the Rights Management Workshop, we show you how you can bring out your organisational structure in the wiki via rights. Together, we analyse and specify your individual and complex rights structure and implement it for you.

The rights structure you need - for example group rights, rights to read and write in specific namespaces, the right to delete pages and many more - are determined and recorded systematically in a matrix. After this, we configure your wiki via remote access according to your ideas and the rights matrix we have created.

The aim is to set up your rights structure completely so that you can get to work on your wiki straight away and manage the rights in the future yourself. Your rights system can be expanded and fine-tuned on the basis of the groups and namespaces we develop together.

- Determining the rights-specific structure of the wiki
- Querying roles (user groups)
- Creating a rights matrix that fits your requirements
- Mapping the optimal rights structure of your wiki
- Allocating initial rights as a basis for further development
- Coordinating and documenting with our customer service management

The Rights Management Workshop lasts half a day and is conducted via an online meeting. It consists of four units of 45 minutes each for a maximum of six participants. Also as part of the workshop, we will configure the rights matrix we develop together on your wiki.

The **Rights Management Workshop** sets up an initial rights configuration in your wiki, and gives you the skills to extend it.
